PARK GUIDELINES

Accommodation and sites

- Plastic drop sheets are not permitted on grassed areas. Only breathable matting is allowed.
- No blues tarps allowed.
- Tents are to be moved within sites every 5 days.
- The person whose name appears on your receipt is responsible for the conduct of all members of your party and any visitors.
- The management reserves the right to terminate any permit to occupancy giving one hour's notice at any time.
- Smoking is strictly forbidden in all on-site accommodation, amenities blocks and pool/community kitchen areas.
- All fees for sites and accommodation must be paid in advance. Please be sure of your minimum stay requirements, as no refunds are issued on accommodation not used.
- Registered site holders have the responsibility of booking in any extra persons staying with them and paying the appropriate fees upon their arrival. A fee applies for any day visitors wishing to use the showers. All visitors must vacate the park by 10pm.
- Check-out time for all sites and accommodation is 10.00am.
- Guests are responsible for locking their vehicles and securing their possessions.

Vehicles

- Only one vehicle per site. Extra vehicles must be left outside the park.
- For the safety of all guests, the speed limit within the park is strictly 8km/hour (walking pace).
- Caravans and vehicles may not be washed within the park.
- Manager's permission is required before carrying out any maintenance or trade work on vehicles or caravans.

Children

- Parents are responsible for their children in the park and are expected to supervise their behaviour.
- Children 8 years and under are not permitted in the showers, toilets or laundry unless accompanied by an adult.
- Bicycles are only to be ridden on park roads slowly and with care.

Daily Living

- No undue noise after 10pm. Please ensure that your television is not disturbing your fellow campers.
- Please use a bucket under sink waste or connect a hose from your caravan waste to the gully trap.
- Temporary clotheslines are not permitted.
- The community kitchen is available for use until 10pm.
- Please put all rubbish in plastic bags before placing in rubbish bins.
- The laundry is open from 7am to 9pm daily.

Television Reception

The park is cabled from a main antenna. You should be able to pick up SBS, ABC, Seven, Nine and Ten. Caravan sites require a cable to connect to the main antenna. The connection is located next to your power outlet. Cables are available at the office for a \$50 refundable deposit.

Transport

Sun Bus runs regular services to Smithfield, Redlynch and Cairns. The bus may be caught at the nearby general store. Timetables are available from the office.

Courtesy buses are available from the park to the Red Beret Hotel and to Yorkey's Knob Yacht Club.

RULES FOR OWNERS REGARDING PETS AT LAKE PLACID TOURIST PARK

Lake Placid Tourist Park is a pet friendly park. However, not all of our guests are pet lovers, so it is imperative that pet owners are considerate of others. If you or your pet breaks any of the following rules more than once, your stay will be terminated. The acceptance of any pets into the park is always at the discretion of the park management.

- All pets must be declared
- We need to be mindful of pet lovers as well as those who are not. When walking your dog, please try to get them out on the front nature strip for their ablutions, and avoid as much as possible having them water every tree on the way.

- Pets are allowed at the manager's discretion, with a limited number of dogs accepted during the busy season.
- Pets are not allowed in any park owned, on-site accommodation.
- Pets are not allowed in the pool area or in the amenities blocks.
- Dogs and cats must be on a leash at all times or securely tied up at your accommodation.
- Excessive noise, such as barking or aggressive behavior towards other campers or their pets will result in you being asked to remove your pet from the park, or to leave.

- Dogs must not be left unattended in the park during the day. The park management will be happy to recommend local day care for your pet.
- You must clean up after your pet immediately.
- We do have limited pet friendly accommodation.
